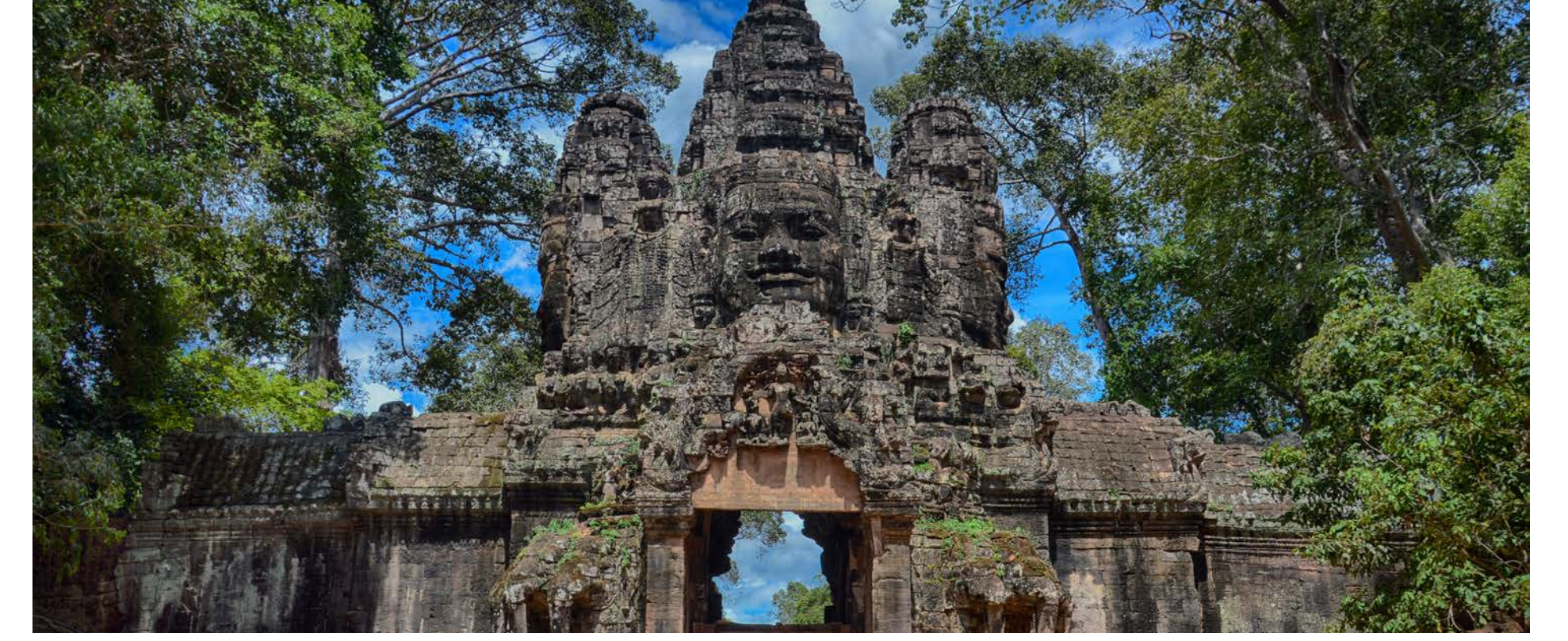


# HUMANITIES, ARTS AND SOCIAL SCIENCES (HASS)
