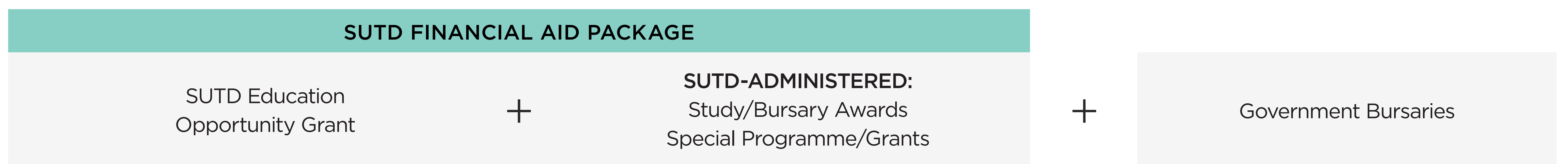
1 Applying for Financial Aid (FA)



*If you are in National Service and have a place reserved in SUTD, you may apply for FA in the year of enrolment.

2 SUTD Financial Aid Package

Based on your assessed financial need, you will receive a financial aid package which could consist of the SUTD Education Opportunity Grant, SUTD-administered study/bursary awards, grants, or a combination of these awards to complement the Government Bursaries.

On top of the above FA schemes, you may also tap on other financing options such as loan schemes and the Post-Secondary Education Account (PSEA).

3 SUTD Education Opportunity Grant (SEOG)

The SUTD Education Opportunity Grant (SEOG) aims to help students with demonstrated financial need offset their educational expenses at SUTD. The quantum of financial support you receive will be tiered based on your financial circumstances. In particular, eligible students with the greatest financial need will be guaranteed a financial package equal to 100% of their tuition fees, as well as full coverage of hostel fees for the Freshmore terms where hostel stay is compulsory.

There are no additional interviews, no bonds and no limits to the number of recipients. With this upfront guarantee, you can now take financing out of your enrolment decision.
