

**SYNOPSIS** - The abundance of data has promoted a technology-centric view of a Smart City. Human Smart Cities emphasise the role of citizens, their needs and a bottom-up approach to urban development and improving the quality of lives of citizens. In this talk, examples of how digital technologies have been used to visualise data to enhance knowledge and raise awareness among citizens to engage them in their communities and neighbourhoods will be presented. In addition, experiences from an European project on Human Smart Cities, MyNeighbourhood, will be shared.
